

Friday 3 and Saturday 4 October

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our Open Event and would like to provide you with further information to allow you effectively and efficiently to plan your time with us.

Timings

Please arrive promptly at your allocated time slot (this can be found on the confirmation email you received from *TryBooking*). Please enter only via the main entry point: the courtyard of the Old Building, the white Tudor building on the High Street. **Registration** will take place in School Room which is just off the historic courtyard. When you pass through this area – please have your **QR code** from your *TryBooking* confirmation ready for scanning.



There are no fixed timings other than the *Insider's Guide to Admissions* which is showing every 10 minutes (from the hour) in **Zone G**. Do watch this before chatting to the Admissions team.

Your whole visit should last approximately 2 hours, depending upon the number of zones visited. Our Open Day will close promptly at 8.30pm on Friday night and 12.00pm on Saturday afternoon; as the Old Building is at the beginning of the tour this area will close slightly earlier.

Passport

Your son will be given a passport on arrival so that he can get it stamped in each zone throughout his visit. Before you leave, your son should collect the highly-coveted official RGS Pencil from the foyer in the Main Building as well as a copy of the prospectus and *The Review*.

Zones

The attached map details the locations of the various zones. We would recommend visiting approximately 5 or 6 zones, but it is totally up to you! Please do plan to visit the zones most relevant to your son's interests. Further details are provided below.

There are no one-to-one student guides as we want you to chat to as many students as possible from all year groups. Students are dotted around the site as human signposts. They are there to help – ask directions, fire questions at them, or just stop for a chat.

The Headmaster will be available to speak to in person in Great Hall, as well as other senior members of staff, including our Pastoral team.

SMALL PRINT

- Some areas are accessed by a number of stairs, others are outside. For those with mobility issues, not all areas are easily accessible; this includes access for pushchairs. Please also bring an umbrella if the weather is inclement.
- There is no parking on site but there are plenty of public car parks close by in Guildford town centre. Please leave enough time to park as the traffic may be busy.
- Our stunning 20-acre Sports Grounds in the beautiful Surrey countryside are not available but please do take our word for it – they are well worth a visit!
- Should the fire alarm sound, please follow the directions from RGS staff and prefects who will safely lead you outside.
- **Toilets** are available outside **Zone H**, just downstairs from the entrance into the Main Building.

TOP FIVE (DON'T MISS!) TIPS

- Pastoral: If our students are happy then the rest takes care of itself: smiley, confident individuals who have a strong sense of belonging within a supportive community. Come and speak to our Pastoral team in Great Hall pastoral leaders, Heads of Year, Tutors, Learning Support, Counsellors, School Nurse and ask them anything at all!

- **Daily life:** Come and fire questions at our panel of students about any aspect of daily life at the RGS. Ask absolutely whatever you like! What are the best things to do at breaktimes? What's the food like? Are the lessons fun? Any question goes.
- Headmaster: The Headmaster is available throughout the event in Great Hall. Watch beforehand the Headmaster's welcome talk via the link provided, then take the opportunity to chat to the Headmaster individually in person. No need for specific questions. Just have a chat!
